




































French knots - one strand wound twice round the needle

Notes

Material Type: Aida Generic White

Sewing Count: 14/inch or 55/100mm

Design Size: 50 x 50 stitches

Sewn Design Size: 3.6 x 3.6 inches or 91 x 91 mm

Suggested Material Size: 9.5 x 9.5 inches or 241 x 241 mm

Stitch Style: Cross-stitch Using 3 strands PLEASE USE just 2 strands
